

CEVA announces expanded market presence in Portland, Oregon

Expanded facility increases CEVA's Portland footprint by 32%

Houston, USA, 29 April, 2015 – CEVA Logistics, one of the world's leading supply chain management companies, has expanded its market presence in Portland, Oregon (PDX) through enhancements to its existing facility including 33,300 sq ft (3,065 sq m) of additional Class A warehouse space, incorporating 14 dock doors with 4,400 sq ft (408 sq m) of additional office space.

The company's Portland operations, located five minutes from Portland International Airport, now encompass a total of 154,675 sq ft (14,370 sq m) and 51 total dock doors. The newly-remodelled facility will enable CEVA to expand all service offerings as well as capacity in the Portland market. The area has a particularly high demand for value-added logistics services.

The facility, located at 8830 NE Alderwood, Road, in Portland provides a broad array of supply chain and logistics services including Domestic and international freight, customs brokerage, retail pool distribution, warehousing, and value-added services such as pick and pack, as well as kitting and light assembly. CEVA's Portland operation provides services to widely-known global brands and enjoys deep partnerships with popular locally-based brands in the market. CEVA's Portland operation has provided one-stop solutions for importing, warehousing and distribution that have helped fuel local companies' growth.

CEVA’s permanent staff in Portland totals more than 70 people, including on-site U.S. Customs Brokers. A fleet of 25 independent owner-operator vehicles also supports local pickup and delivery operations.
